The Oncomap™ test is a genomic test that can help guide timely treatment options by providing personalized insights from an analysis of your tumor. Your cancer tissue is analyzed to identify changes or mutations in the structure of your tumor's genes. This information can help your doctor identify available targeted treatments and immunotherapies that are most appropriate to treat your cancer. The test identifies clinical trials associated with your type of cancer and can provide valuable data and analysis to inform treatment decisions where no standard of care exists.

Genomic Profiling – The Key to Knowing Your Cancer

Cancer treatment is not a one-size-fits-all solution, because everyone's cancer is unique. 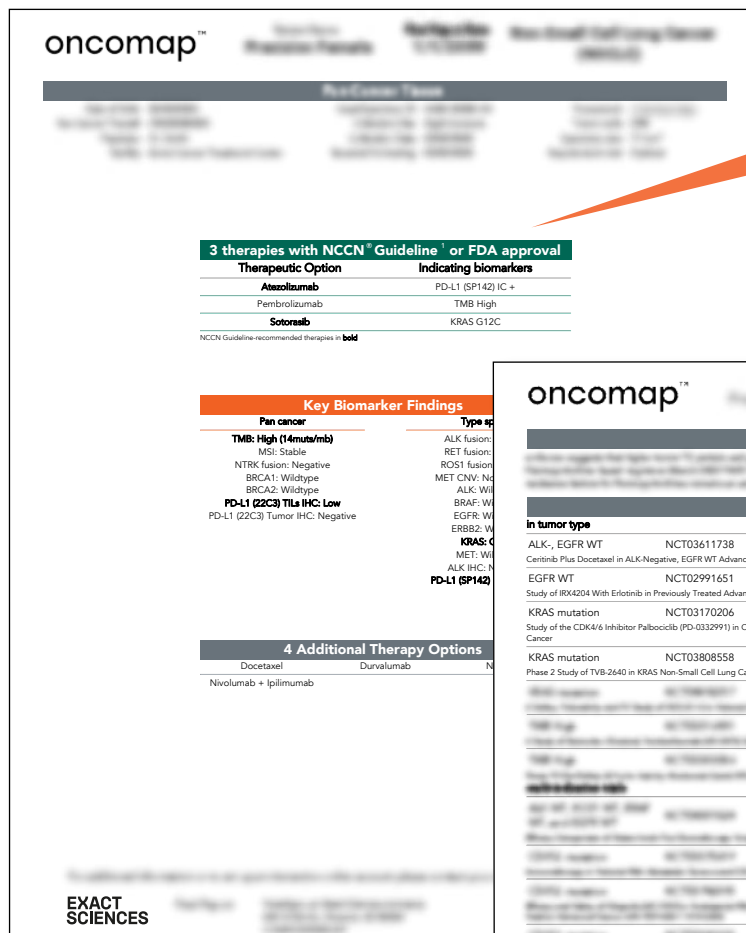
How Does it Work?

	1. The tissue from your tumor that has already been biopsied or removed is sent to our lab for analysis. No additional procedures are required. The test is used to create a profile of your unique cancer.
	2. Test results are sent to your doctor in the form of a report.
	3. You and your doctor review the results together to determine your personalized treatment options.

What Can I Expect from My Test Results?

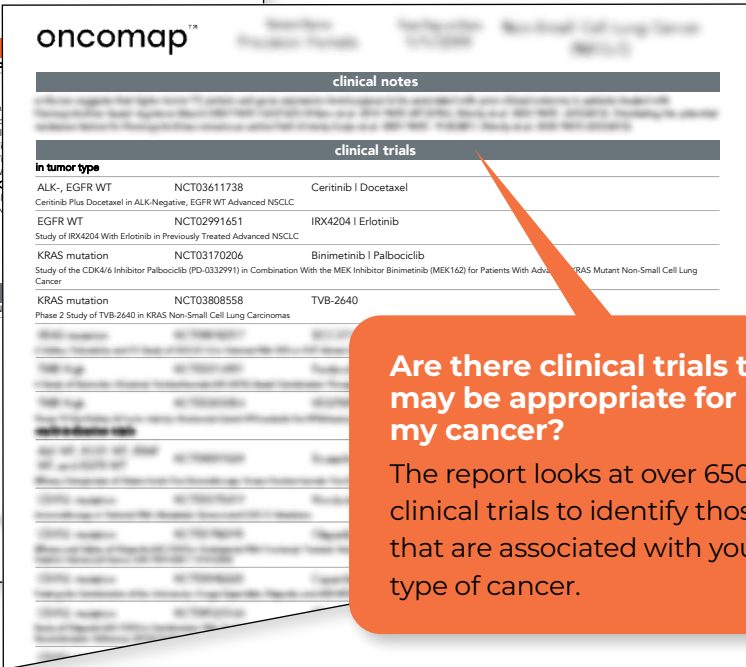
Once the tumor sample is sent to the laboratory, the cancer's DNA is analyzed, and the Oncomap test is used to create a profile of your cancer's unique makeup.

The report identifies therapeutic options and available clinical trials based on biomarkers identified from the genomic profiling of your cancer's tumor and can help answer questions such as:



Which therapeutic options exist for the identified biomarkers in my genomic profile?

The report will identify available treatments and immunotherapies that will target your cancer.




Are there clinical trials that may be appropriate for my cancer?

The report looks at over 650 clinical trials to identify those that are associated with your type of cancer.
